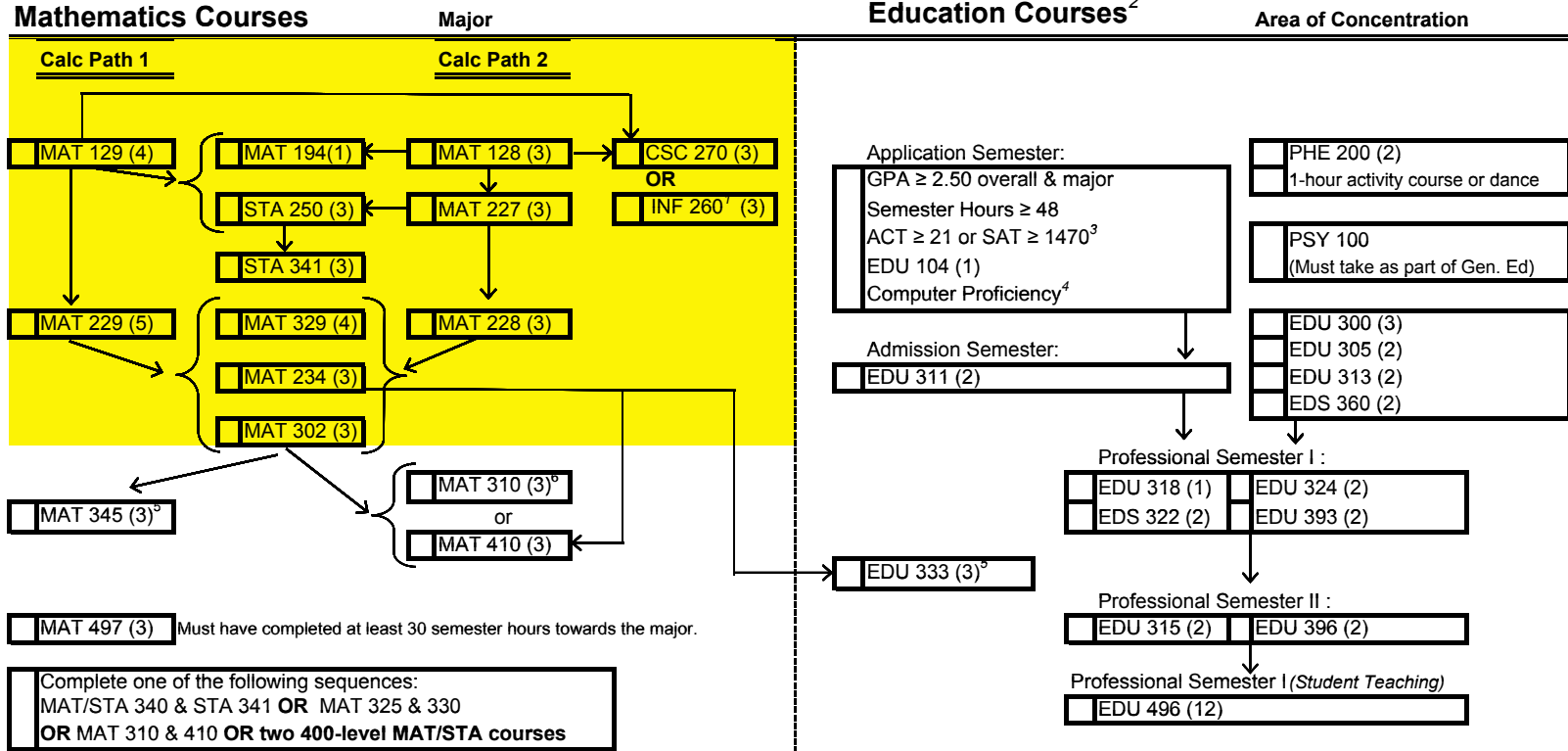


# MATHEMATICS WITH SECONDARY EDUCATION OPTION – (as of 2008)



**Notes:**

- <sup>1</sup> INF 260 has INF 120 as a prerequisite and is an alternate to CSC 270
- <sup>2</sup> This is a four semester sequence with longer time periods allowed.
- <sup>3</sup> Includes writing portion of test
- <sup>4</sup> Computer proficiency is satisfied by CSC 270 or INF 260, and is required for EDU 313.
- <sup>5</sup> This class is only offered in the Fall Semester
- <sup>9</sup> This class is only offered in the Spring Semester

**Requirement Information:**

If total semester hours do not equal 44, then an additional course at the 300-level or above will be required.  
 Recommend either have taken or taking MAT 345/310 prior to taking PRAXIS (certification requirement) exams (061 & 063) in mathematics  
 Recommend completion of core courses (shaded) before applying to the Education Program  
 EDU 104 is required for all education majors  
 EDU 300, 305, 313, 360 may be taken before or during Admission Semester.  
 Professional Semesters I & II are blocked during morning hours and must be taken consecutively.  
 Completion of at least 85% of course work in the major is required prior to student-teaching.
